

## HOW TO GET THERE FROM BRUSSELS

---

### Via E19

- » Coming from Brussels (E19)
- » In the Craeybeckxtunnel follow direction Gent and follow Antwerp's ring road
- » Take exit 5a ("Het Zuid", "Centrum", "Antwerpen-Schelde-Hoboken")
- » At the traffic lights go left
- » Pass the new courthouse (Bolivarplaats) on your left, keep driving straight ahead onto Jan Van Gentstraat
- » Our underground parking (level -2) is located in Pacificatiestraat, i.e. first street on your right on Jan Van Gentstraat

## HOW TO GET THERE FROM GHENT

---

### Via E17

- » Coming from Ghent (E17)
- » Take the first exit ("Boom-Hoboken-A12") immediately after coming out of the Kennedy Tunnel
- » Keep to your left and follow direction "Antwerpen-Centrum"
- » Take the tunnel under the new courthouse and turn left on the first traffic lights onto Graaf Van Hoornestraat
- » Then the second street left
- » At the roundabout (Lambermontplaats) you take the third street on your right (Emiel Banningstraat)
- » There, you take the second street at your right (Pacificatiestraat), the end of this street is Jan Van Gentstraat
- » Our underground parking (level -2) is located in Pacificatiestraat

## HOW TO GET THERE FROM TURNHOUT-HASSELT

---

- » Follow Antwerp's ring road in the direction of Gent
- » Take exit 5a ("Het Zuid", "Centrum", "Antwerpen-Schelde-Hoboken")
- » At the traffic lights go left
- » Pass the new courthouse (Bolivarplaats) on your left, keep driving straight ahead onto Jan Van Gentstraat
- » Our underground parking (level -2) is located in Pacificatiestraat, i.e. first street on your right on Jan Van Gentstraat

---

- » Follow Antwerp's ring road in the direction of Gent
